## Important Information

- The \$5.00 regular rate will be added for tuition paid after the first week of each pay period.
- Classes continue and students are enrolled for the full school year of 41 weeks.
- Tuition payments are due every four weeks and are non-refundable. You do not need to re-enroll each pay period. No refunds for missed classes for any reason. Make-up classes are allowed. Credit will be given for: Labor Day, Thanksgiving Break, Memorial Day.. Classes cancelled due to weather may be made up within 8 weeks. Because most students make up these classes, you must see the desk if you want credit.
- We offer a 10% discount for 2 or more family members enrolled or a student taking 2 or more classes per week.
- There is a \$20.00 annual registration fee per family. The registration fee and last month's tuition are due when registering for a class. A 30 day notice must be given to our office if you are withdrawing from a class by coming in and signing and dating your registration form. The last month's tuition will be used for the 30 day notice. If not pre-registered, first and last months tuition are due the first week of classes.
- All students must wear appropriate dance attire and shoes; (leotard and tights or leggings, unitard, or tight fitting dance clothing.) Ballet students 6 years and older must wear tights and have hair up.
- There will be a recital costume fee of \$50.00+tax (up to 8 yr. old class) and \$55.00+tax (9 yr. old class & up) which is yours to keep (not a rental). Half is due Nov. 2<sup>rd</sup>, half is due Nov. 16<sup>th</sup>. Any costumes not paid by Nov 21<sup>st</sup> will get charged a \$10 shipping fee due to separate shipping.
- All information will be posted on the bulletin board. Please read, or have your child read, the bulletin board each week.
- Nutcracker tickets go on sale Sat. Oct 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:00AM in West Bend. Recital tickets go on sale Sat. April 3<sup>rd</sup> at 10:00AM in Mequon.
- All dance classes are in the spring recital. Any student wishing to be in the annual production of The Nutcracker Ballet must take ballet for the school year and summer preceding the show.
- Cancellations due to weather will be on TV channels 4, 6, and 12 and does not necessarily go with school cancellations.
